This sale is sure to be a big hit, as it is jam packed with rarities, high grade and quality lots that are all

well priced along with bargain offerings and some of the most interesting and unusual highlights around!

Key items on offer in this fantastic sale include a Type 8 Kookaburra Penny, one of the keys to the series, with only a few examples known, and a coin that is rarely offered. Estimated at \$200,000, this coin is sure to draw widespread interest from those wanting to attempt to complete a full set. An extremely rare 1855 Sydney Mint Half Sovereign is also on offer, and estimated at \$45,000, is sure to be snapped up. A rare Specimen 5 Pound 1960 is priced to sell with an estimate of \$30,000, as well as a unique polymer \$5 Specimen from 1995. These alone offer a fantastic chance for keen collectors to obtain some unique and rare notes!

Banknote highlights include the only



Rare South Africa Boer War Ein Pond gold issue known Pre Decimal 1 Million Starnote (a 7 digit starnote) - a 5 Pound with serials 100000*. This amazing note is the pinnacle of the Million serial number series, and is the only Pre Decimal example known (with only 1 other decimal example recorded). Estimated at \$30,000, this rare and unusual note is sure to excite! A 1 Pound 1961 with million serial numbers keeps the theme going, and in high grade, is a note that is seldom seen.

Other banknotes of note include the finest known 1 Pound 1918 consecutive pair, in original virtually as printed condition, that have never been offered as a pair before, and estimated at \$60,000 represent great value given the premium a pair of early issue notes in high grade is worth. An extremely rare Colonial Police Fund uncut pair of notes from 1813 in EF condition is another lot sure to draw widespread interest, as is a seldom offered ES&A Superscribed Emergency Issue 1 Pound. Also on offer is a set from 1 to 10 Pounds of National Bank W.A Specimens, along with a number of issued and Specimen Pre Federation banknotes.

Other Rare Pre Decimal notes include

a 10 Shillings and 1 Pound red serial type 1913, a rare UNC pair of 10 Pounds 1934, and a 1 Pound Collins-Allen in aUNC. A rare 5 Pound Specimen 1960 headlines a nice collection of Specimen notes including a Type I Specimen set, whilst a good selection of Starnotes, Misprints and Decimal including polymer, first and last prefixes, test notes and more is included.

Coin highlights include the usual comprehensive selection of Pre Decimal coinage, comprising both Proof and circulation issues in gold, silver and copper. Highlights include a full 1938 Proof set, an UNC Type 6 Kookaburra Penny, a gEF/aUNC 1923 Halfpenny with some mint red, a rare Overdate Sydney Mint



A few of the rare Ancient Gold Coins
