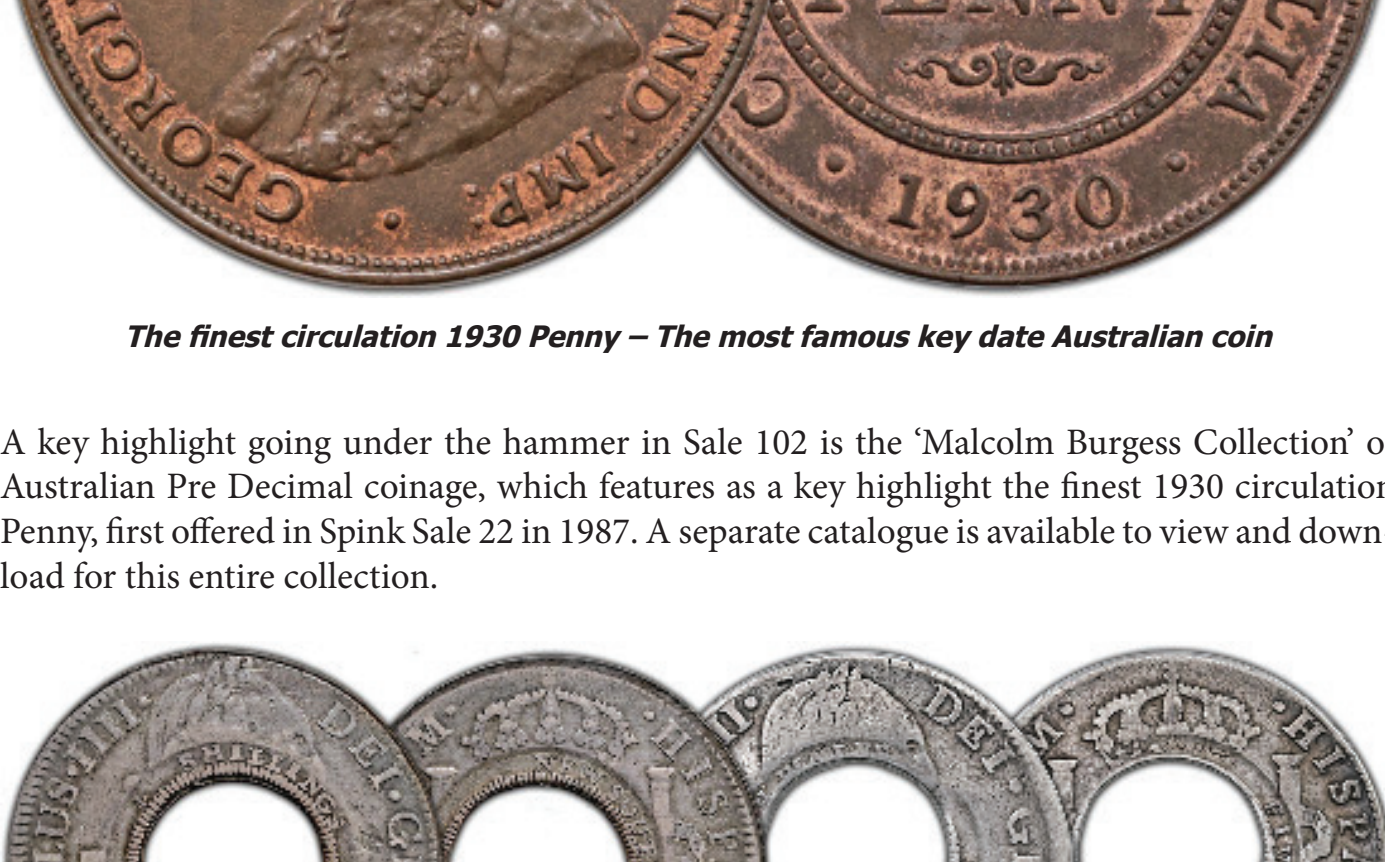

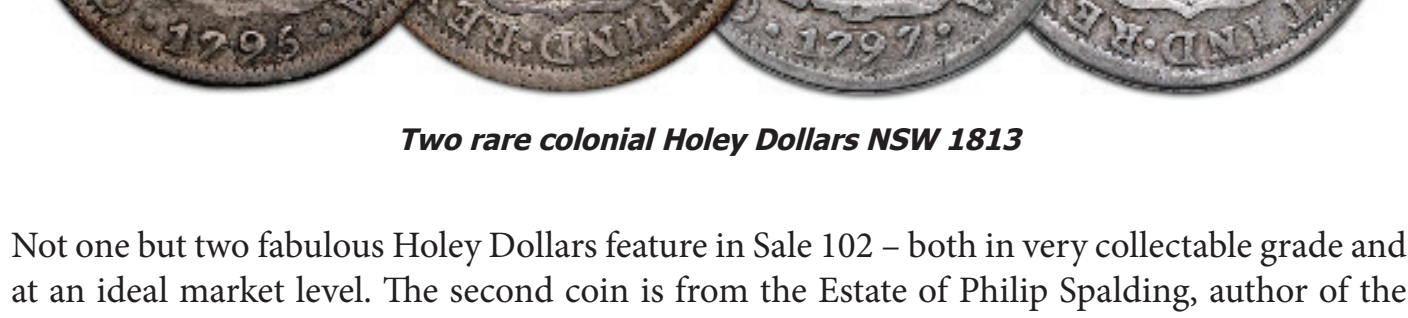

***The finest circulation 1930 Penny – The most famous key date Australian coin***



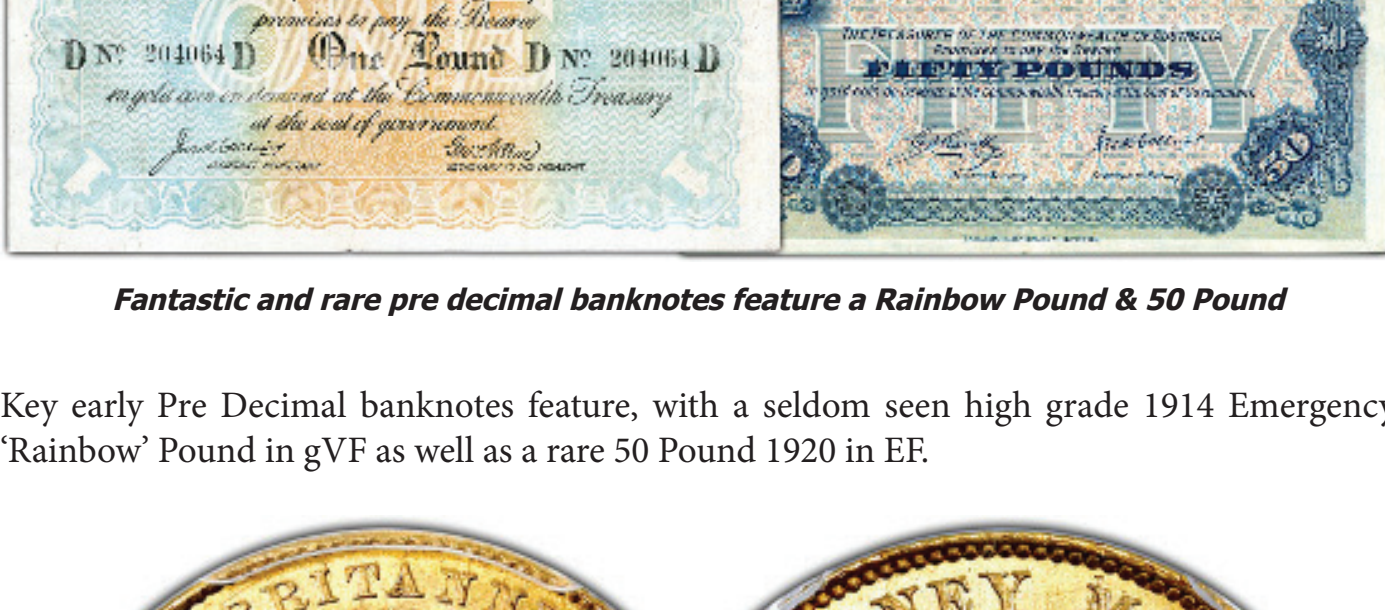
***Two rare colonial Holey Dollars NSW 1813***

Not one but two fabulous Holey Dollars feature in Sale 102 – both in very collectable grade and at an ideal market level. The second coin is from the Estate of Philip Spalding, author of the standard reference book, *The World of the Holey Dollar*.



***The famous 'Crowned Head' George V Kookaburra pattern penny Type 10***

The most unique looking and famous of the Kookaburra Penny series is the George V Crowned head type. Only a few of this rare type is known to exist, and as such places this type right at the top of the Kookaburra Penny hierarchy.



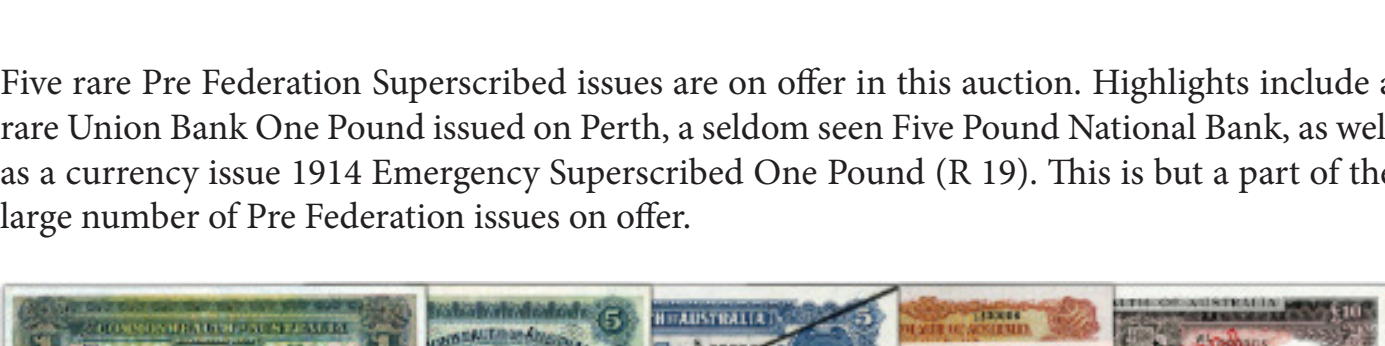
***Fantastic and rare pre decimal banknotes feature a Rainbow Pound & 50 Pound***

Key early Pre Decimal banknotes feature, with a seldom seen high grade 1914 Emergency 'Rainbow' Pound in gVF as well as a rare 50 Pound 1920 in EF.



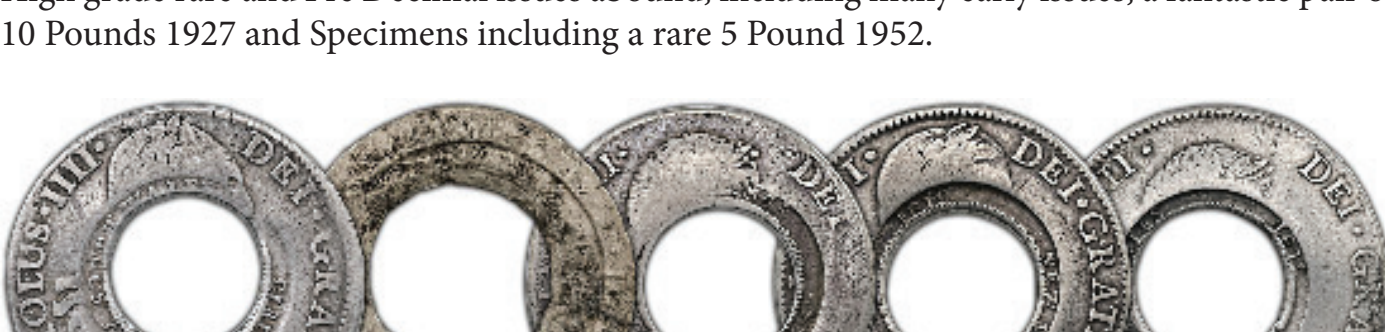
***The Second finest known 1855 Sydney Mint Sovereign MS 63***

The 1855 Sydney Mint Sovereign has top provenance, being ex the Quartermaster collection and the second finest example known. This famous first year of issue coin is in stunning condition and is one of the absolute key coins of the gold series.



***Three extremely rare Pre Federation superscribed issued Banknotes***

Five rare Pre Federation Superscribed issues are on offer in this auction. Highlights include a rare Union Bank One Pound issued on Perth, a seldom seen Five Pound National Bank, as well as a currency issue 1914 Emergency Superscribed One Pound (R 19). This is but a part of the large number of Pre Federation issues on offer.



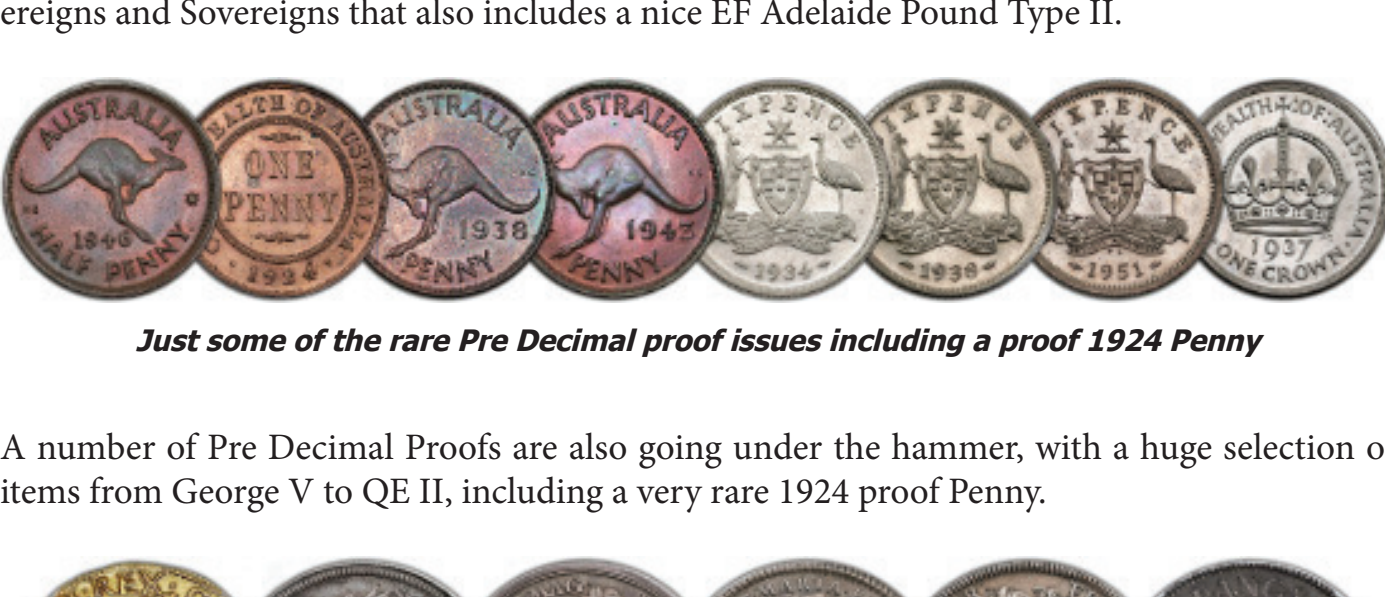
***Other key and rare Australian banknotes from pre decimal to specimens***

High grade rare and Pre Decimal issues abound, including many early issues, a fantastic pair of 10 Pounds 1927 and Specimens including a rare 5 Pound 1952.



***Philip Spalding 1813 Holey Dollar NSW & contemporary counterfeits***

As mentioned above, the 1797 Holey Dollar in the Sale is ex the Philip Spalding estate. As well there are several other pieces of great interest – various contemporary forgeries. All listed in *The World of the Holey Dollar* book as well as Mira, and even includes one coin that was (unfortunately for the forger) struck on an 1814 host coin!



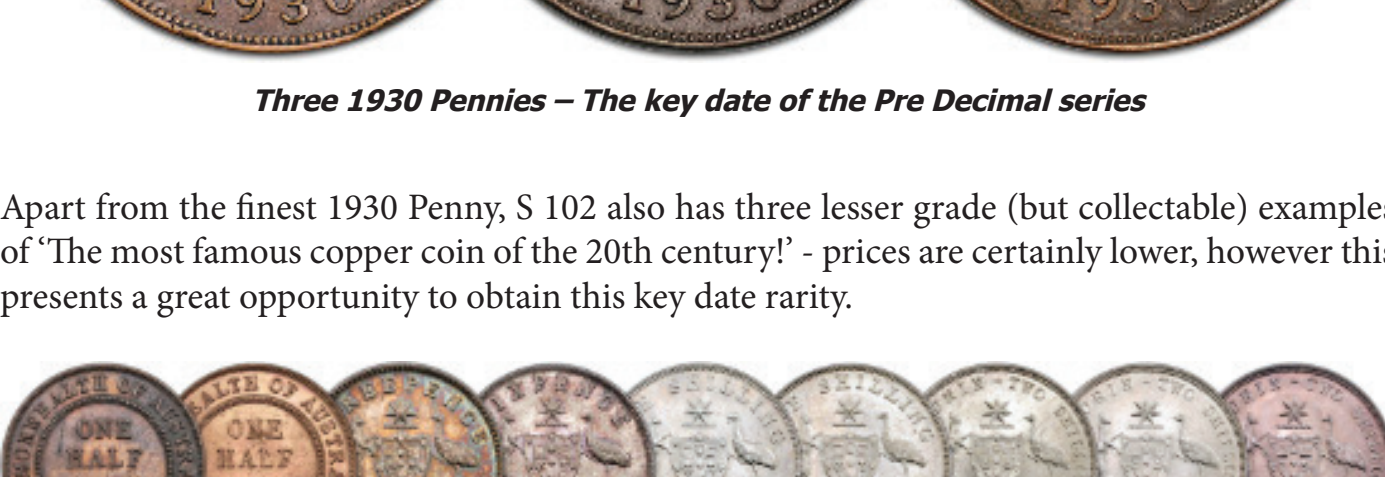
***Superb proof 1890M Half Sovereign and 1852 Adelaide Pound Type II***

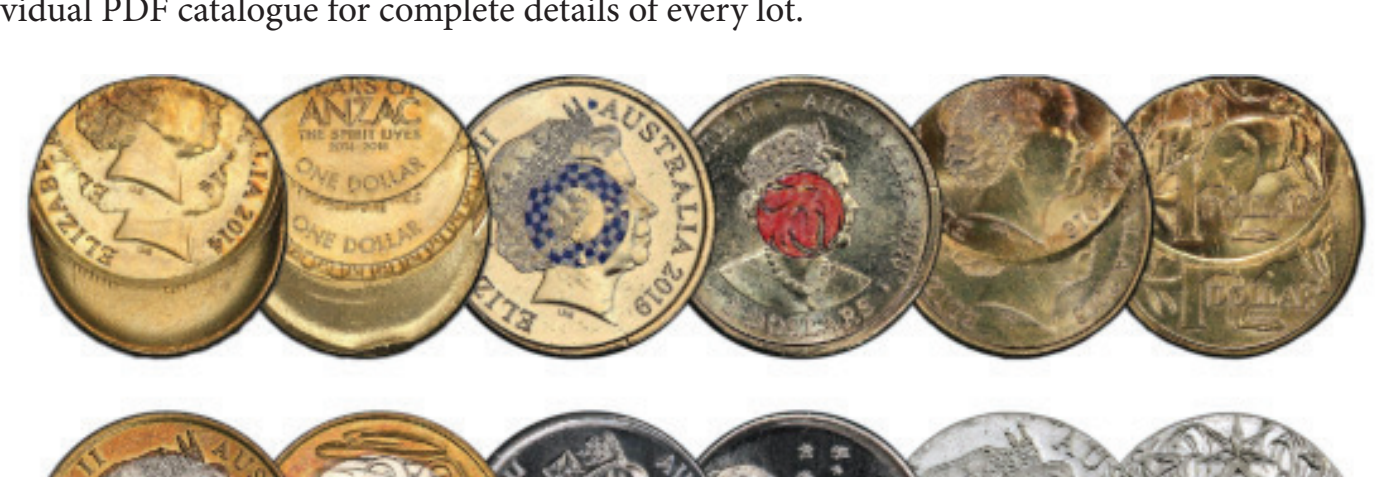
***Just some of the rare Pre Decimal proof issues including a proof 1924 Penny***

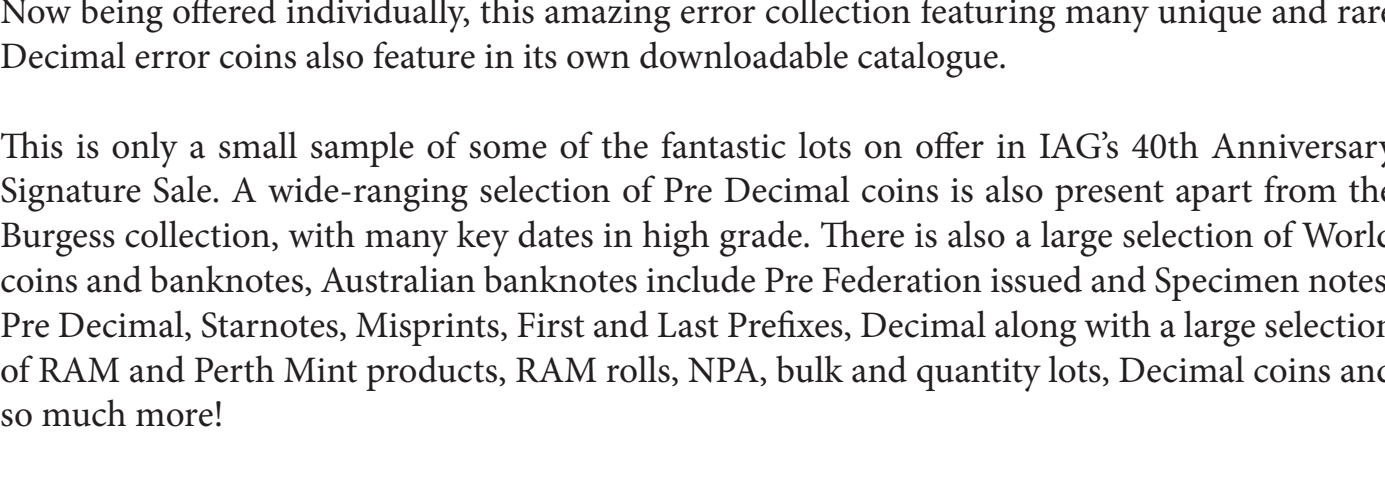
***Three 1930 Pennies – The key date of the Pre Decimal series***
