# ESOTERIC/ECLECTIC PAPER AND POLYMER AUSTRALIAN NOTE COLLECTION

## Foreword

This extensively curated collation of Australian promissory, private issue, superscribed, Treasury, Harrison gold-bearing, Ash legal tender, George VI and QE II paper to modern polymer, military, Hay and Cocos-Keeling notes seeded predominantly from individual, key paper notes purchased from Ray Whelan in 1973, and is the second part; the Pre Federation and high-denomination notes having been sold in Nobles in April 2004 to fund a house purchase.

As Stewart Burton recounts, *"The core of Treasury/Harrison/Ash paper notes was derived from Ray Whelan advertising in Australian Coin World in October 1967 (much to the angst of John Gartner of Australian Coin Review). I located the original advertisement whilst doing post graduate studies in geology in "The Stack" Fisher library, Sydney University as I was researching carbonatites, and as they both began with c my interest was piqued.*

*I contacted Ray in 1973 when the number of Australian note tragics could be counted on two hands. As luck would have it he still had all listings and so began my own note tragic obsession. These notes pre-date most Australian Numismatic auctions and have not been offered for sale since.*

*Around this time Note Printing Australia echoed the Australia Post style of "value adding" with designer and uncut polymer aka Flint's Folly. I on sold my collection of these to the late Trevor Wilkin as Flint's Folly combined with Jackman and Pettit was generating a devolution to an Australian note tragic.*

*The 1832 Augusta promissory note deposited in the Derwent Bank in Van Dieman's Land ex Noble Numismatics sale 78 (lot 4599), had Jim Noble send me a letter "This note is for you". It had been extricated from the Salamanca markets in Hobart by Bill Mira, and cannot be considered to be merely a promissory note, but a museum piece!*

*The 10 Pound R52b originates from the 1977 Max Stern sale of the Keith Deutscher collection."*



## PROMISSORY NOTES



- 660 First Bill of Exchange 1-8-1832 for 72 Pounds, 3 Shillings and 1 Pence. Issued at Augusta and payable to Captain Molloy by John G Bussell, addressed to Captain Swanston; Director of Derwent Bank, Van Diemens Land and endorsed on back by Molloy. An important historical item linking the settlement in Western Australia with Van Diemens Land. Piece missing from right edge otherwise on large piece of paper, multiple pinholes and punch hole. Extremely rare. Ex W.J.D. Mira Collection and Nobles S 79 July 2005, lot 2873. John Molloy 1780-1867- fought with the 95th Regiment in the Peninsular War and later at Waterloo where he was badly wounded. He received the Military General Service Medal with 8 bars and the Waterloo Medal. In 1830 he and his wife to the Swan River Settlement disembarking from the 'Warrior' at Fremantle in March 1830 and was granted land at Augusta. He became a JP and then a resident Magistrate, and later gazetted as a lieutenant Colonel. VF
